Sheila A. Smith, an expert on Japanese politics and foreign policy, is senior fellow for Japan Studies at the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR), where she also directed CFR's Regional Security Architecture for Asia program.

Dr. Smith joined CFR from the East-West Center in 2007, where she specialized on Asia-Pacific international relations and U.S. policy toward Asia. She was also recently affiliated with Keio University, where she researched and wrote on Japan's foreign policy on an Abe Fellowship. From 2004 to 2007, she directed a multinational research team in a cross-national study of the domestic politics of the U.S. military presence in Japan, South Korea, and the Philippines. She has been a visiting researcher at two leading Japanese foreign and security policy think tanks, the Japan Institute of International Affairs and the Research Institute for Peace and Security, as well as at the University of Tokyo and the University of the Ryukyus. Dr. Smith earned her Ph.D. and M.A. degrees from the Department of Political Science at Columbia University.
